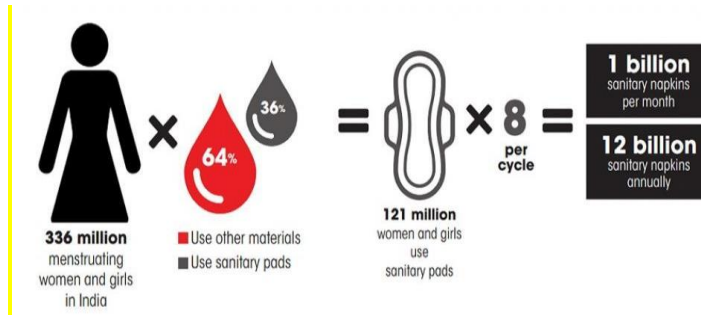

Executive Summary

This report provides an overview of the distribution of 140 Menstrual Health Hygiene Kits as part of Swachhta Pakhwada, organized by REC Limited in collaboration with Nav Astitwa Foundation. The kits were distributed to underprivileged women and girls on 26th May 2023.

Background

REC Limited, a Maharatna CPSE under the Ministry of Power, celebrated Swachhta Pakhwada from 16/05/2023 to 31/05/2023, with various planned activities. As part of these initiatives, a work order (REC/RO/PAT/Swachhta/2023-24/194) was issued on 19/05/2023 to Nav Astitwa Foundation for procuring and distributing 140 Menstrual Health Hygiene Kits.

Implementation

Nav Astitwa Foundation successfully procured and distributed 140 Menstrual Health Hygiene Kits to underprivileged beneficiaries on 26th May 2023. The distribution took place at a venue arranged by the NGO.

Financials

The total expenses incurred for the procurement of the kits amounted to INR 50,000, including miscellaneous expenses. The breakdown of the costs is detailed as follows:

- No. of Kits: 140
- Unit Rate: INR 350
- Amount (incl. GST): INR 49,000
- Miscellaneous Expenses: INR 1,000

Request for Donation

Nav Astitwa Foundation has formally requested REC Limited to provide the donation amount for the 140 Menstrual Hygiene Kits. Invoices referencing the work order have been submitted for review.
